GRAND PRIX CIRCUIT RULES

ADULT RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Player Classification: SATA Grand Prix tournaments use the USTA NTRP numerical system. The range will be from 5.0 +, 4.5, 4.0, 3.5, 3.0 and 2.5. **All prior year Top 8 winners and High Point Winners must move up to the next highest level the following year.** Appeals may be made to SATA.
2. This amateur tennis circuit is designed for adults, 19 and older. Occasionally junior players will register and are restricted to compete in the 4.0 or higher division. It is the responsibility of the junior player to understand this rule.
3. Players who intentionally “sandbag” may be defaulted without being refunded. If you are not sure which class you should play in, you should speak with the tournament director.
4. To register for a tournament, (a) obtain an entry form from the tournament, or (b) download a standard entry form from the SATA website: www.sactennis.org.
5. Follow instructions to obtain your match times. It is your responsibility to obtain your times if you do not hear from the tournament director.
6. All tournaments will follow general USTA rules and regulations; however, each tournament may include separate club rules and guidelines to personalize their tournament.
7. Coaching is not permitted during tournament play.
8. All players and spectators are expected to follow facility rules and regulations.
9. The management and operation of each tournament is under the sole direction of the facility hosting the tournament. All questions regarding the operation of the tournament should be directed to the tournament director.
10. All questions regarding player points and rankings may be directed to SATA.
